

Call for a volunteer from Ukraine

We are looking for a young person (age 18 – 30) to be a volunteer at the printing project [druckkammer] in Greifswald from 05.09.2022 until 31.08.2023 in the EU volunteering programme „European Solidarity Corps“

What's the project?

[druckkammer] is a printing project in Greifswald, North-East Germany near the Baltic sea. There's always something happening there. Our idea is to come everyday with new ideas, help people express through art and teach everything we know about printmaking, papermaking and all the other aspects of art we've got the knowledge about.

As a volunteer you'd work in a small German-English-Polish speaking team. It means working together with people but also being independent and responsible for your own tasks so from time to time it's also about finding the work that needs to be done and managing the time on your own.

[druckkammer] is a perfect place for you if you like to work with people, you're interested in art, want to learn something new everyday and have the will and energy to talk about what you think is important.

In this challenging time we are especially looking for a volunteer from Ukraine. The time as a volunteer can be used to specifically express feelings and thoughts about the war through art – or it can be about something completely different. Depending on your needs and wishes.

As a volunteer you will...

- learn everything you want to know about printing
- be a part of the team with equal rights
- work with different people: groups, individuals, youngsters and older ones
- be a part of preparing exhibitions, creating motives for different projects and finding new ways to work with participants of [dk]'s workshops
- be part of a network of other international volunteers and spend several weeks of seminars together, organized by the coordinating organisation Turbina Pomerania
- receive pocket money and money for food expenses each month, free medical-, travel-, and third-party insurance, reimbursement of travel costs
- have the opportunity to study German during your voluntary year
- live together with other international volunteers in a shared apartment, with you having your own room and sharing bathroom, kitchen and living room with the flatmates.

How to apply?

Residents from Ukraine currently need no visa to travel to Germany. You will be supported with all necessary administrative aspects.
